### *Credit Recovery*

#### **Purpose**

To allow students the opportunity to recover credit for course failed during the school year. Summer school is based on a semester system and credit will be given on that basis.

\$150.00 per semester credit for district students

### *TAKS Camp*

#### **Purpose**

An intensive review designed for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have failed any portion of the Exit Level TAKS test.

#### **Location**

#### **Tuition**

This review course is offered at no charge to students who are scheduled to take the TAKS Exit Level Retest in July.

## High School Summer School Guidelines

1. Any student dismissed from summer school because of discipline will forfeit all tuition.
2. If a student withdraws after beginning a course, tuition will not be refunded.
3. A student is subject to loss of credit after missing more than one (1) day of summer school.
