## Middle School Summer School Guidelines

1. Middle School students may take Summer School to raise their yearly average.
2. Any student dismissed from summer school because of discipline will forfeit all tuition.
3. If a student withdraws after June 10, 2009, tuition will not be refunded.
4. A student is subject to loss of credit after missing more than one (1) day of summer school.
5. Four (4) tardies will equate to one absence.
6. Students will be properly dressed and groomed according to the standard of the regular term.
7. Campus and WISD Code of Conduct will apply. Students will be given specific rules on the first day of class.
8. All WISD students will be placed in classes on a priority basis. Out-of-district students will be placed in classes based on class load availability.
9. A class must have a minimum of fifteen (15) students to be held.
