Starting next school year, students will have the opportunity to enroll in accelerated science classes. Students in the Accelerated Science Pathway will take biology in 8th Grade. The accelerated pathway will allow students more room in their schedules to take higher level courses in high school.

Overview

- Curriculum will be accelerated; all state standards will be taught
- 6th, 7th, and 8th grade curriculum will be completed in 6th and 7th grade
- 8th grade Science STAAR will be taken at the end of 7th Grade
- Biology and Biology EOC exam will be taken at the end of 8th Grade

Summer Camp

- June 3-20, Monday through Thursday, 9-3:30pm
- Will be at Willis High School
- Parent will provide transportation and lunch
- Minimum of 20 students
- Cost will be \$150
- Will cover most of the 7th grade curriculum through hands-on, lab based activity
- Remainder of 7th grade will be completed in August into September
- 8th grade curriculum will begin fall of 7th grade year
